Article: 1 Prior Year Bills

MAJORITY VOTE

Article: 4 Appropriation to Town Reserve Fund and Accrual Liability Funding MAJORITY VOTE

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the sum of \$72,680 from Certified Free Cash, with \$55,000 to the Town's Reserve Fund and \$17,680 to the Town's Accrual Liability Funding or take any action relative thereto.

MAJORITY VOTE

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum of \$63,269, \$21,165 from the Tax Levy, \$1,052 from Water and \$1,052 from Sewer Retained Earnings, and \$40,000 from Article 4 as voted at the May 9th, 2016 Annual Town Meeting all to be added to the Fiscal 2017 year appropriation as voted at the May 9th, 2016 Annual Town Meeting, for salaries, wages and contract settlements of union and non-union employees, full and part-time employees of the various town departments as listed below and further to authorize the Town Accountant to make the necessary disbursements to the various respective salary and wage line items as voted at the May 9th, 2016 Annual Town Meeting or take any action relative thereto.

MAJORITY VOTE

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the sum of \$25,000 from Waterfront Enterprise Fund Certified Retained Earnings for the purpose of funding repairs, renovations, and restoration work within the facilities and properties of the Mattapoisett waterfront, or take any action relative thereto.

Article: 9 School Security Improvements

MAJORITY VOTE

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$60,000 from Account 01-306-797-5841-17 to Account 01-306-797-5820-17 as voted at the May 9^{th} , 2016 Annual Town Meeting for the purpose of funding the construction of school security systems and measures at Center and Old Hammondtown Schools, and to take any action relative thereto.

Article: 10 Funding of Public Safety Staffing Positions

MAJORITY VOTE

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the sum of \$30,985 from the Tax Levy for the purpose of funding staffing needs of the Police and Fire Departments as follows:

FT Fireman salaries and wages \$10,000
